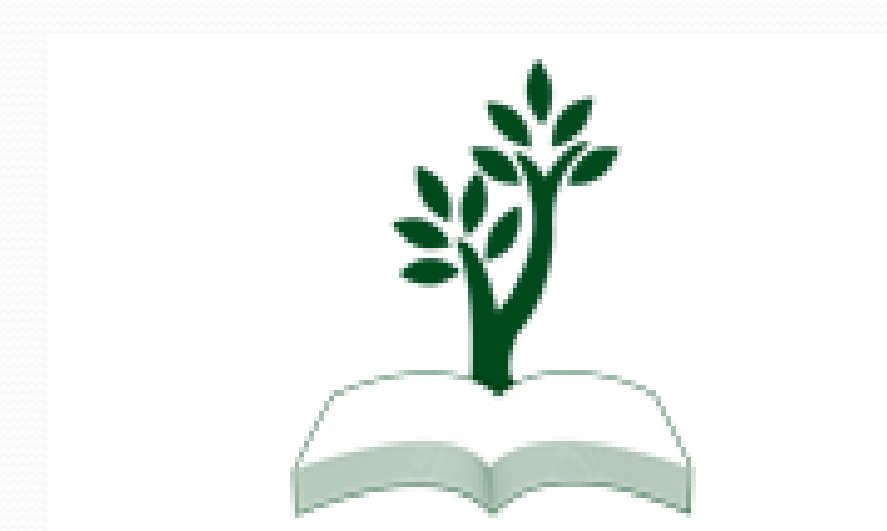
PARTNERS:

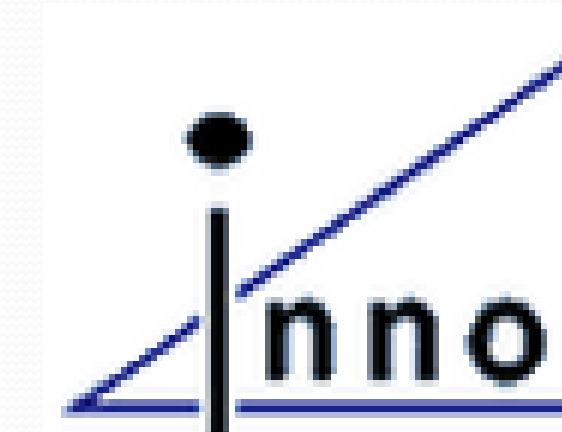
- Twinning activities

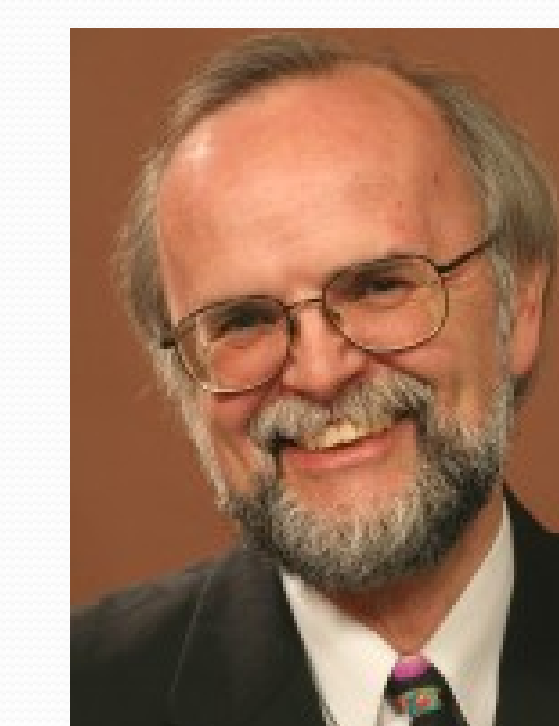
