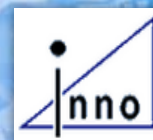

Dear colleagues!

The BIOPARTNERS project team (“Georgian-Europe Wide Enhanced research Links in Biotechnology”), funded by the European Commission, part of the 7th Framework Program ERA-WIDE, is organizing an International Summer School for young scientists **“Enhancing Health Promoting Compounds in Food ”** which will be held in Bazaleti Training Center – Georgia from September 8 to September 10, 2014.

It is our great pleasure to invite you to participate in this summer school.

Participation in this summer school will open the opportunity for young scientists to attend a series of lectures **in the fields of food security and safety, food processing, analysis and quality control, novel foods and supplements, and current development in drugs production from food ingredients**. World renowned scientists from Georgia, Caucasus and Europe will share their knowledge and experience with the participants.

Through this Summer School, attendees (young scientists) will have the opportunity

- to widen their knowledge and experience in the field of biotechnology
- to consult experienced researchers
- to present their research results and discuss them with experienced researchers
- to establish professional relationships for future career opportunities
- to get experience in participation in international scientific activities and programs including in FP7

The main objectives of this summer school are:

1. To get in touch with the academic community of Georgia with prominent European Professors and researchers, active in FP7 and other European research project, enhancing the links of local community with Europe in the area of Food Technology.
2. To give the opportunity to recruit new students and candidates of the region for participating in research.
3. To create an environment for high quality scientific brainstorming and interaction between European and local researchers, increasing the horizon of Georgian researchers and stimulating the participation in common projects.

The summer school will have lectures in the following areas:

Recent Advances in Food Processing, Analysis and Quality Control

Bioactive Components from Food and Food Supplements

From Food to Pharmacy

Bringing Food Technology to Market.



We invite young scientists (**undergraduates, graduates, postgraduates, PhDs, researchers, etc.**) under the age of 36 from different countries of the world to take part in the International Summer School « **Enhancing Health Promoting Compounds in Food** ».

Registration

Anyone who wants to participate in the International Summer School must **register online** on web-site: <http://biopartners-dibb.ge/summer-school-home.htm> and prepare an abstract and CV containing personal data, information about education, labor activity, main scientific research directions and list of scientific works and send them to the organizing committee by email: before June 20, 2014. The Organizing Committee will review submitted materials and will select the 28 participants on a competitive basis. The list of the participants will be published on July 20, 2014 on the website of the International Summer School «**Enhancing Health Promoting Compounds in Food**».

Summer School Schedule

The program of the training school will focus on training scientists through lectures.

The participants of the Summer School (young scientists) are obliged to attend all lectures and presentations of the school.

Grants for young scientists

Young scientists will be provided by grants which will cover their participation in the lectures and round table discussions, printed program and materials, book of abstracts, accommodation in "Bazaleti Training center" with three meals a day. **The grant will not be paid in monetary form and will not cover transportation expenses.**

Certificates

Students who will properly attend the Summer School will receive a **Certificate of attendance**. The certificates will be given during the closing ceremony of the Summer School.

Venue

The conference will be held at **Bazaleti training center** in a very beautiful village Bazaleti about 60 km from Tbilisi, the capital of Georgia. The training center is well equipped with modern facilities. There is a large conference hall, and free Wi-Fi.
